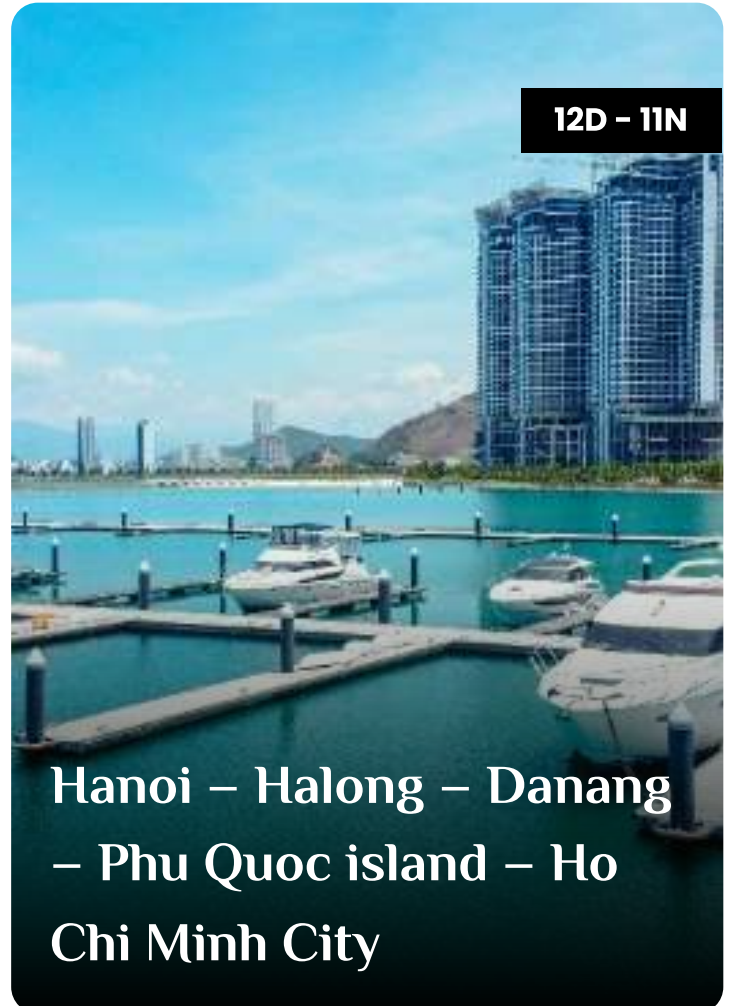
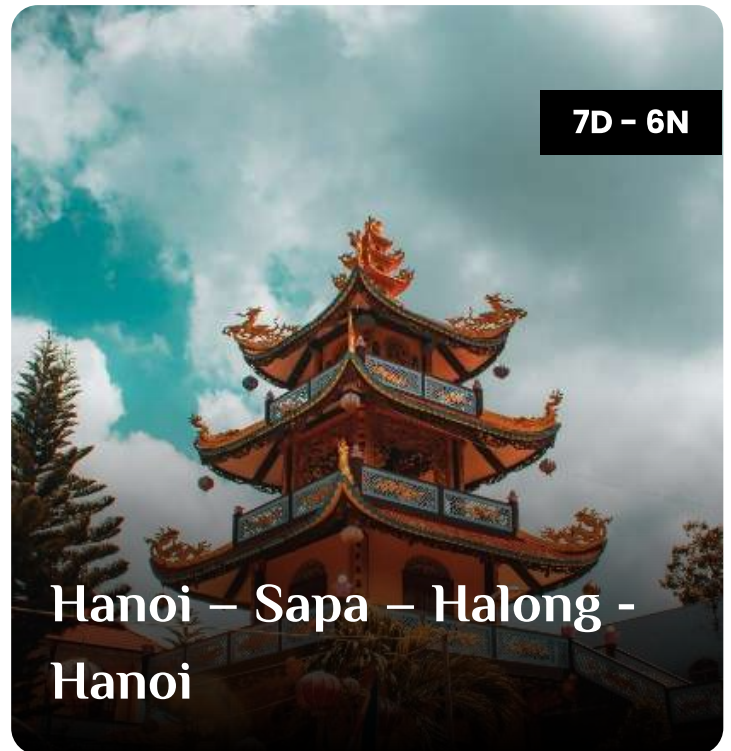
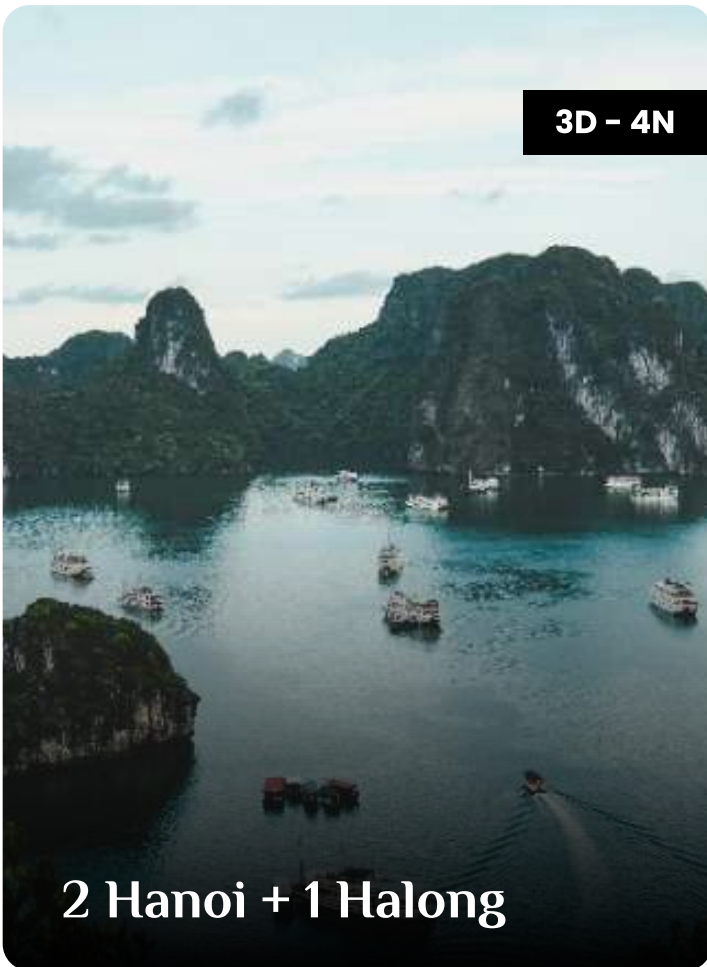

Da Lat

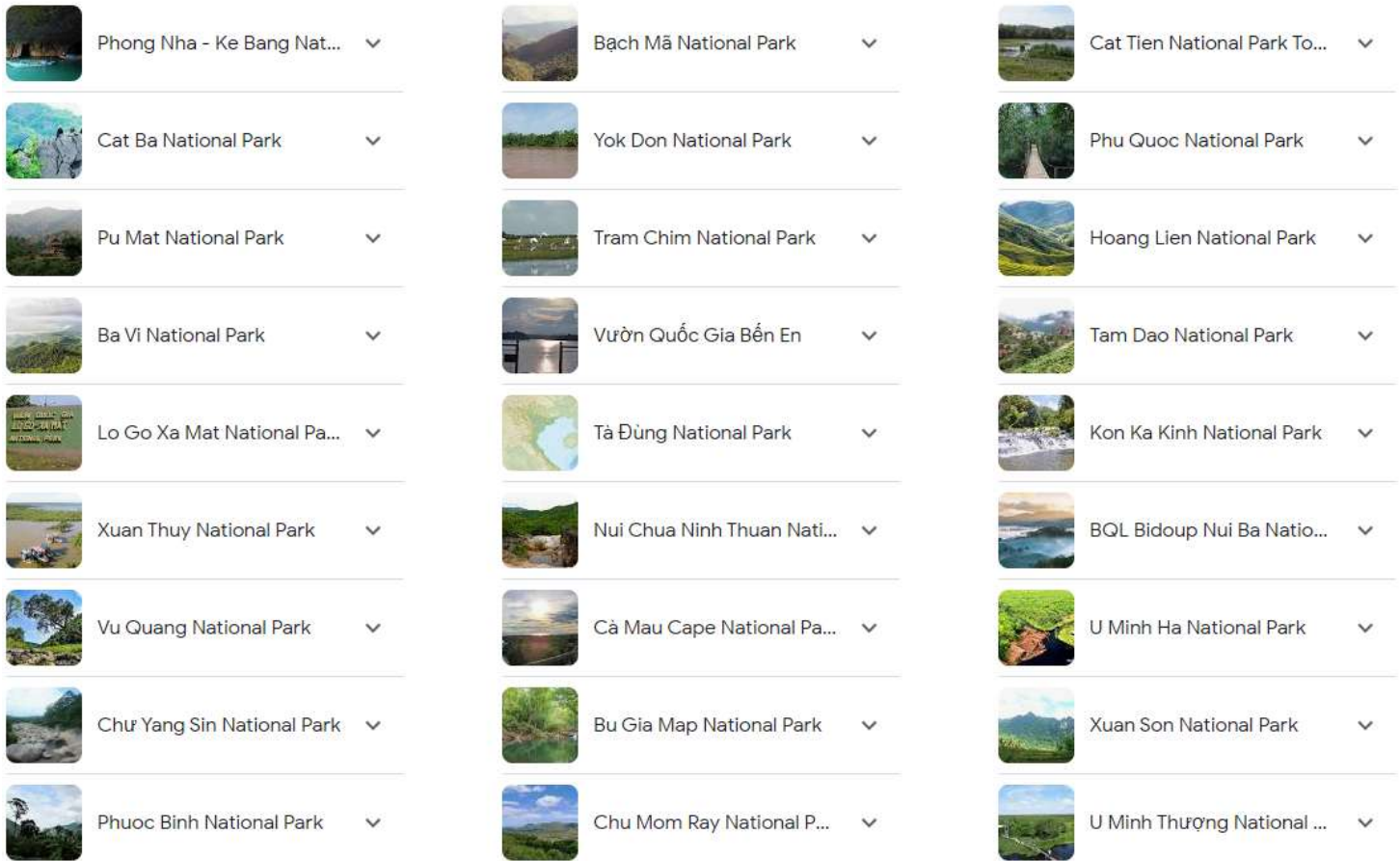

National Parks



- 1. Phong Nha - Ke Bang National Park:** Phong Nha-Kẻ Bàng National Park is a protected area in north-central Vietnam bordering the Hin Namno Reserve in Laos. Characterized by mountains, tropical forests and underground rivers, it's known for its ancient limestone karsts and vast network of caves. These include the huge Sơn Đoòng cave and Phong Nha cave, which is big enough for boats. The area's rich wildlife includes tigers, black bears and elephants.
- 2. Cat Ba National Park:** Cát Bà National Park is a World Heritage Site designated as a biosphere reserve in northern Vietnam. The park is part of Cát Bà Island in Hạ Long Bay and is administered by the city of Haiphong.
- 3. Cat Tien National Park Tours:** Cát Tiên National Park is a national park located in the south of Vietnam, in the provinces of Đồng Nai, Bình Phước and Lâm Đồng. It is approximately 150 km north of Ho Chi Minh City. It has an area of about 720 km² and protects one of the largest areas of lowland tropical forests left in Vietnam.
- 4. Hoang Lien National Park:** Hoang Lien National Park is a national park within Hoang Lien Son Range, in the districts of Sa Pa and Than Uyên of Lào Cai Province, and part of Phong Thổ District in Lai Châu Province in Northern Vietnam. Its area is 68,569 hectares with terrain mostly between 1,000 to 3,000 meters above sea level
- 5. Pu Mat National Park:** Pù Mát National Park is a national park in Nghệ An Province, in Vietnam's North Central Coast region. It is part of the Western Nghệ An Biosphere Reserve. In the Thai language, Pù Mát means "high slope"

Things To Know Before Travelling To Vietnam

Visa requirements:

Travellers to Vietnam must have a valid visa to enter the country. Some nationalities can apply for a visa on arrival, while others must apply for a visa in advance. It's important to check the specific visa requirements for your nationality and the length of your stay before travelling to Vietnam.



Currency:

The official currency in Vietnam is the Vietnamese Dong (VND). US dollars and euros are also widely accepted, especially in tourist areas. It's a good idea to have some local currency on hand for small purchases and tips.



Weather:

Vietnam has a tropical climate, with high temperatures and high humidity year-round. The best time to visit is during the dry season, which typically lasts from October to April. The rainy season is from May to September, which can affect travel plans and make some areas inaccessible.



Transportation:

Vietnam has a well-developed transportation system, including buses, trains, and flights. Taxis and motorbikes are also widely available, but be aware of the traffic and the risks involved in riding them.
